



ANDREY YAKOVLEVICH PROKOPCHUK WENT TO BE WITH JESUS



On December 7th we said goodbye to the body of Andrey Yakovlevich Prokopchuk who was the oldest minister in our association. He was 105 years and 2 months old. He was a person of incredible testimony, a minister, well-known for his sacrificial life and dedication to the Lord, and who was used by God in different countries such as Paraguay, Argentina, Brazil, the U.S., and Belarus.

As Vyacheslav Mihailovich Tsvirinko, who was the previous president of PCSBA said in his letter, "A true friend to all ministers in the harvest of God went to be with the Lord. We no longer have a representative of a totally different epoch

among us."

THE USA RECOGNIZED JERUSALEM AS THE CAPITOL OF ISRAEL

We often do not realize the times during which we live and how many signs of the Second Coming of Christ are happening before our very eyes. On December 6th, President Donald Trump announced the acceptance of Jerusalem as the capital of Israel. He also gave an order about moving of the American embassy from Tel-Aviv to Jerusalem.

The world leaders had mixed reactions about this event. Some thanked God yet again for our President, for his faithfulness to the promises as a presidential nominee, and for his support of the chosen people. There were also those who put him down and think that this is one more of his impulsive decisions which will permanently set in motion the process of having less stability in the world. The Gospel Gerald Society published summary article about the issue which represents the views of six Christian world leaders who are in support of President Trump's decision. One of those who openly support the President is the daughter of Billy Graham, Anna Graham-Lots, who not only respects the President's decision but also called the Christians to stop in the holiday business of today and "unite with one heart and one voice in order to thank the lord for the President's decision, and to pray for the peace in Jerusalem".
