The first issue was published on June 11, 1966 with 1,500 printed copies. At the present time, newspapers are being sent out to many different countries. However, the number of subscribers in the continental USA continues to fall. Now the question arises about the future of the newspaper in the U.S. The chief editor of the newspaper, Ivan Bruyako, addresses this issue. 
WOMEN'S PRAYER BREAKFAST AT GRACE AVENUE BIBLE CHURCH


EASTER CELEBRATION FOR THE GYPSY CHILDREN OF UZBEKISTAN
